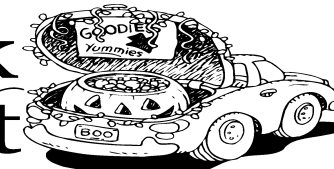
### OCC NEEDS

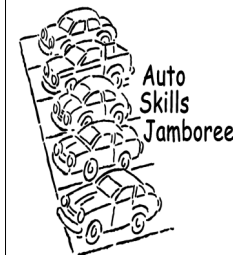
